that the box is bound with metal strips one (1) inch in width or more and eighteen (18) inches apart,
that between the metal casket and the box is a filler of sawdust or wood shavings of a thickness of
not less than 13/4 inches, that in the chest and in the abdominal cavity of the body was injected at
least one quart of a 3% solution of bichloride of mercury or a 5% solution of phenol, and the body
was wrapped in a sheet saturated with a 3% solution of bichloride of mercury.
